RE: Monitoring Well Installation Along Willard Avenue and North Drive, Farmingdale

To Whom it May Concern:

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has contracted Environmental Assessment & Remediations (EAR) & AARCO Environmental Services to install monitoring wells along the street/sidewalk on Willard Avenue adjacent to Hart Street and along North Drive between West Drive and Sunset Drive. This work is being conducted as part of a groundwater quality investigation and monitoring associated with DEC Spill# 8302032.

Please be advised that drilling is scheduled to begin as early as **September 20, 2023** and is expected to be completed in two weeks. Work will begin after 8 am, Monday through Friday, and will require the use of heavy equipment in the vicinity of Willard Ave and North Drive. Efforts to minimize the impact and inconvenience to the local neighborhood is a priority, however, equipment may remain secured on the side of the road after working hours. Restoration will comply with the Town of Oyster Bay's Department of Public Works specifications for sidewalk and roadway construction methods.

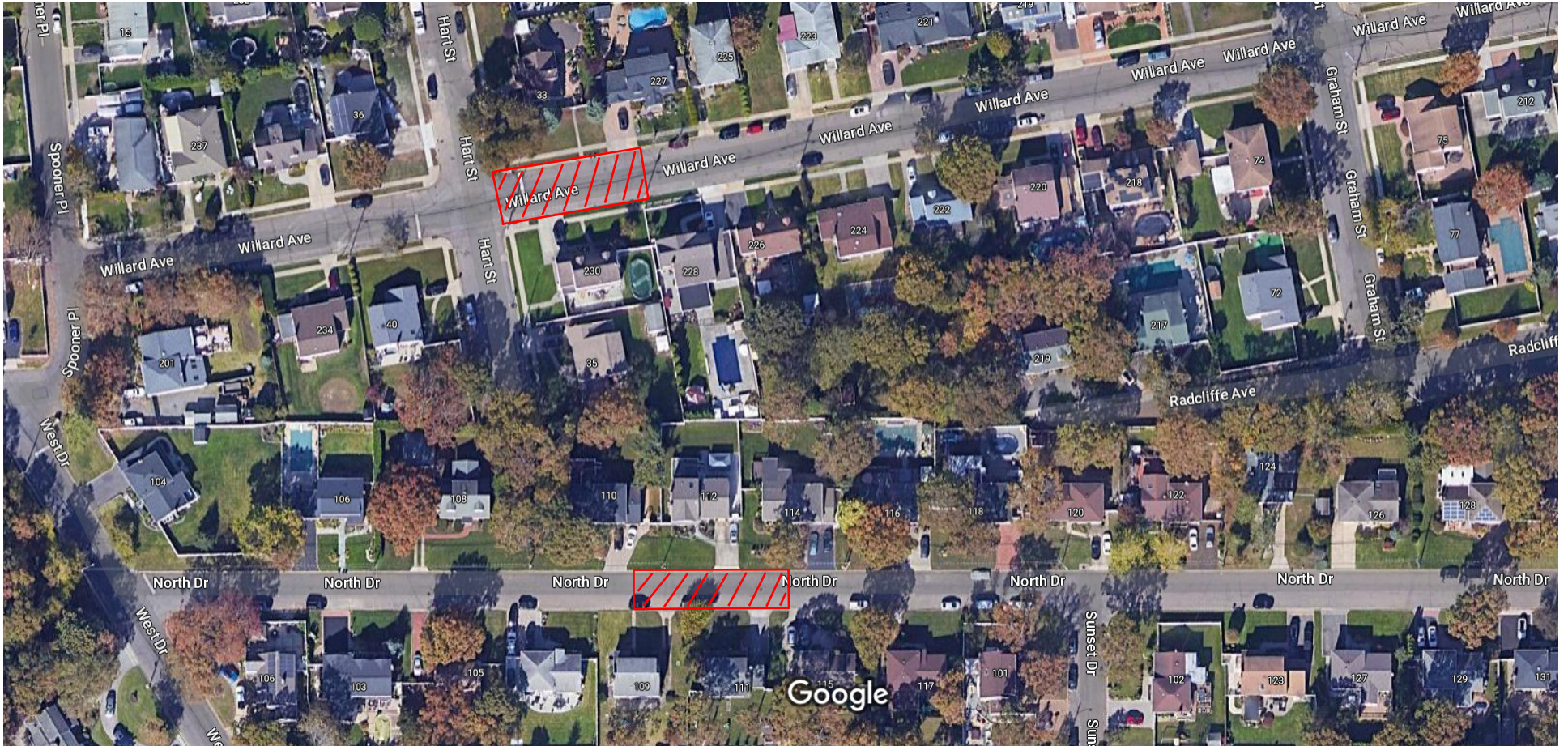
