## HYDRANT PERMIT INSTRUCTIONS (updated 3/25)

There are 3 types of hydrant use scenarios at present:

1. Landscapers (including 'tree sprayers')
2. Contractors
3. Fundraisers

**LANDSCAPERS** are currently required to pay an annual fee:

\$100.00 application fee, plus

\$20.00 per vehicle for unlimited tank refills - "unmetered" water sales.

- An application is required. Cash or check to be collected in advance.
- A payment receipt must be completed. Mark the payment receipt number on the application.
- Give a copy of the approved application, with a raised district seal, to applicant.
- They are restricted to the use of the hydrant located at 40 Langdon Road, Farmingdale, unless - otherwise approved by the Superintendent
- The permit expires at the end of the calendar year.
- Landscaper vehicles must be inspected by South Farmingdale Water District before an application may be approved.

**CONTRACTORS** currently are charged \$300.00 per month (unmetered water sales)

- An application is required. Money must be collected in advance, in cash or certified check.
- A payment receipt must be completed. Mark the payment receipt number on the application.
- Give a copy of the approved application to the applicant. (with a raised district seal)
- The hydrant to be used depends upon the location of the job.
- Applicant must provide sufficient notice so as to allow SFWD opportunity to test and flush the hydrant.
- The duration of the permit is to be determined by the Superintendent.
- A backflow device is required on the hydrant. The device and hook up must be inspected and approved by the District. Monthly inspections may be required thereafter for ongoing jobs.

Mark the permit expiration date on public calendar and monitor. Keep the Superintendent / Foreman advised of the job status.

**FUNDRAISERS** There is no fee charged for water use, but a \$100 deposit may be collected for use of a loaner hydrant fitting and loaner hydrant wrench, provided by SFWD. Loaner items must be returned within 5 business days of the event, at which time the deposit will be returned.

- An application is required.
- Give a copy of the approved application, with a raised District seal, to the applicant.
- A deposit receipt must be completed. Mark the receipt number on the application.
- Obtain the applicant's signature on our receipt copy when loaner items and deposit are returned
- The hydrant to be used depends upon the location of the job.
- Applicant must provide sufficient notice so as to allow SFWD opportunity to test and flush the hydrant.
- Mark the event date on public calendar and monitor.
- ***NOTE THAT WHEN METERED WATER IS USED FOR FUNDRAISERS, IT NEED NOT BE REPORTED TO SFWD***
